



## Results Calla year 1 Growing season 2017

A field in the Netherlands planted with year 1 calla tubers was treated three times with the GOOD FOR GREENS® plant growth regulator. At the third spray, a random sample of each treated and control bulbs was collected and chlorophyll was measured in the leaves of 50 plants. The results are graphically shown below.



Graph 1 shows that the GOOD FOR GREENS® plant growth regulator produces more chlorophyll.



Total chlorophyll of the treated sample is 2.216 g for 50 tubers. The control sample has 2.062 for the same number of tubers, meaning an overall increase of 154 or 7%. The treated tubers had higher weight and higher starch and sugar content.

Conclusion: The GOOD FOR GREENS® plant growth regulator increases chlorophyll in year 1 calla plants by 7% and increases weight, starch and sugar content of tubers.
