



Results dahlia pilot

Growing season 2019

Delphy Flower Bulbs and Tubers has tested 23 different bio-stimulants in a statistical block design pilot study on 2 types of dahlia cuttings. The tested dahlia species are Arabian Night and Garden Wonder. The First-Tree B.V. plots (four randomly distributed replications) have been enriched with biochar and have also been treated four times with the GOOD FOR GREENS® plant growth regulator. After lifting the treated and control tubers were collected and weighed. The results are graphically shown below.



Total lifted weight of 24 tubers Arabian Night amounts to 3,782 g for the treated object (FT) and 3,392 g for the average of 2 control objects. This means an overall increase of 390 g or 11%.



In the case of Garden Wonder, total lifted weight of 24 treated tubers (FT) amounts to 5,299 g and 4.189 g for the average of 2 control objects. This means an overall increase of 1.110 g or 26%.

Conclusion: The GOOD FOR GREENS® plant growth regulator increases weight by 11% in Arabian Night dahlia tubers and by a staggering 26% in Garden Wonder.
